



HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED EXEMPTION CRITERIA FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT (ECD) CENTRES

The City of Cape Town is in the process of reviewing the Development Cost charges for Early Childhood Development (ECD) centres. All ECD centres may apply for an exemption of Development Cost charges subject to meeting certain criteria.

It is estimated that 1400 unregistered ECD centres operate within the boundaries of the City. These centres will benefit from the proposed exemption criteria. The proposed Early Childhood Development (ECD) Exemption Criteria are available for viewing on www.capetown.gov.za/haveyoursay. Copies will be made available at subcouncil offices and City libraries.

An information session with the ECD Sector on the proposed ECD exemption criteria will be held at 10:00 on Saturday 16 November 2019, in the Council Chamber, Cape Town Civic Centre, 12 Hertzog Boulevard, Cape Town.

The public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, input or recommendations on the proposed ECD exemption criteria by 30 November 2019.
